PROCEDURES

- Shelter in Place- The buildings are locked and no one is allowed in or out of the buildings.
- Lock Down- The buildings are locked and all personnel are locked down in secure locations. There is no public traffic in the buildings and no one is allowed in or out of the buildings.
- Evacuation Evacuate the building or buildings depending on the situation.
- Reverse Evacuation Go from outside to inside and into a lock down or shelter in place situation depending on the circumstance.
- Shelter- In the event of a weather event, we would shelter in the designated storm shelter areas in all buildings.

If we were to evacuate, we would notify the public of our reunification site and students would be released to the parent or guardian at the reunification site after communicating with the staff member responsible for that child during the evacuation.

What you can do now

- Be sure the school has current phone numbers for your contacts
- Talk to your child about this brochure and let them know the school has a plan to keep them safe

What to do during an Emergency

- Monitor the phone numbers that have been provided to the school
- Do NOT call or come to the school
- Check the Grandfield Schools Facebook page for updates
- Check your email for updates
- Know that we will do everything we can to keep your child safe
- Realize our primary focus will be on student and staff safety and our secondary focus will be district communication with the public. Information will be released as soon as possible.
